**1. Call To Order**

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 PM. Members present were, Charlotte Hernandez, Kara Dodson, Stacy Wright and Alexandria Perez and Staff Liaison Liz Gant. Karl Boss, Gladys Santiago and Courtney Chamberlain were absent from this meeting.

**2. Invocation and Pledge Of Allegiance**

Alexandria Perez offered the invocation and Charlotte Hernandez led the KSB Commission in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**3. Approval of Minutes –February 21, 2017 Meeting**

Alexandria Perez made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 21, 2017 meeting of the KSB Commission. Kara Dodson seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote.

**4. Review/Discuss/Develop - Adopt A Spot Application - Shining Light Ministries**

Representatives of the Shining Light Ministries Church were in attendance and spoke to the KSB Commission about their desire to contribute to the community through litter clean up with the Adopt a Spot Program. The Commission questioned Reverend Olu Olajimi about several aspects of the responsibility of Adopting a Spot. The Reverend stated that the church could provide ten volunteers to clean up quarterly. And they are on track to participate with the Trash Off Event on April 22, 2017. Alexandria Perez made a motion to approve Shining Light Ministries application to Adopt a Spot being Malloy Bridge Road from the Highway 175 Service Road to Kaufman St., Kara Dodson seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote.

**5. Discuss Possible Development: Anti-Littering Outreach Targeting Elementary Age Children**

Members reviewed the final draft of the Dragons Don't Litter Outreach Program. All approved of the content by consensus. Kara Dodson made a motion that KSB funds be used to purchase one sign, Stacy Wright seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote. Liz Gant will visit campuses and enlist them to kick off the program in the fall.

**6. Discuss Malloy Bridge Road Median Adoption**

Members discussed proceeding with Malloy Bridge Road median adoption City crews provided measurements on the medians. Members discussed demolition and rebuild of Taco Bell in addition to the road work currently being conducted on Malloy Bridge Road. Members decided to move forward with recruiting a Dallas County Master Gardener, but feel that the actual work of the project should be delayed until fall.

**7. Annual Trash Off Planning**

Members reviewed the needs list and several committed to contacting local business for donations for the lunch and for door prize drawings. Most members will make contact with school, church and civic groups to enlist and engage volunteers for picking up trash on the day of the event.
