1. Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM. Members present were, Stacy Wright, Karl Boss, Alexandria Perez, Gladys Santiago, Charlotte Hernandez, Kara Dodson, and Staff Liaison Liz Gant. KSB has a vacancy at Place 7.

2. Invocation and Pledge Of Allegiance

Alexandria Perez offered the invocation and led the KSB Commission in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of Minutes –May 16, 2017 Meeting

Alexandria Perez made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 16, 2017 meeting of the KSB Commission. Kara Dodson seconded and the motion passed with a unanimous vote.

4. UPDATE-Discussion: Anti Littering Campaign.

Liz Gant informed Commission members that the City of Dallas Sign shop that fabricates signs for the City of Seagoville had reached out with the news that they wouldn't be able to begin work on the signs until after July 5, 2017. Members suggested trying to make contact and get pricing from an external sign shop that could make traffic quality signs in order to move forward. Liz also indicated she was having trouble making contact at the Elementary schools. The phone rings, but is not answered and does not go to voicemail in order to leave a message. Charlotte Hernandez indicated she will try to find out when staff will report for the school year that begins August 28, 2017.

5. Discuss Yard-Landscape of the Month

Members reviewed the addresses for July nominations for Yard of the Month and Landscape of the month. Each will visit the nominated addresses and text or email their votes to Liz Gant.

6. Discuss-Update Malloy Bridge Road Median adoption.

Liz Gant informed the Commission she had submitted an Increased Service Level request to help offset the costs of the beautification project for Malloy Bridge Road. No updates from Master Gardener Tom Wilton, who has agreed to assist with landscape design for the median.

7. Discuss Litter at Stafford Addition Park

Alexandria Perez had asked that this item be added to the agenda and has since made contact with Community Development Director, Ladis Barr. The department is aware of the issue and has struggled with attendance and membership on the Park Board to help develop ideas for planned park improvements. Trash cans at the park have been stolen. Staff will continue to monitor the park and the litter situation.


