**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_-R-2019**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SEAGOVILLE, TEXAS, APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACTION FOR AN EXPENDITURE OF GENERAL FUND MONIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000.00) TO REPUBLIC SERVICES FOR ADDITIONAL BOOM TRUCK SERVICES FOR STORM DAMAGE CLEAN UP; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on or about June 1, 2019, the City of Seagoville ("City") experienced a microburst that caused heavy storm damage throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens are requesting assistance in cleaning up the damage to their properties as a result of the storm; and

**WHEREAS**, the City does not have the appropriate staff or equipment to assist in cleaning up the excessive amount debris; and

**WHEREAS**, Republic Services has agreed to the rate of \$1,500 per each ten (10) hour day of Boom Truck services to remove such debris and assist in the clean-up in an amount not to exceed \$30,000; and

**WHEREAS**, although the monies have not been specifically budgeted for such services, the money may be pulled from the General Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, believing it to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens, the City Manager has approved Republic Services to begin clean-up; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the foregoing, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens to approve and ratify the City Manager's action for an expenditure of general fund monies in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) to Republic Services for additional Boom Truck services for storm damage clean up as set forth herein.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAGOVILLE, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby approves and ratify the City Manager's action for an expenditure of general fund monies in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) to Republic Services for additional Boom Truck services for storm damage clean up as set forth herein; and, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete the project.

**Section 2.** All resolutions of the City of Seagoville heretofore adopted which are in conflict with the provisions of the resolution be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all resolutions of the City of Seagoville not in conflict with the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** If any article, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this resolution, as hereby amended, be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgment or holding shall not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole or any part or provision thereof, as amended hereby, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is accordingly so resolved.
