 - A. **ZONING REQUEST Z2019-17:** Conduct a Public Hearing, discuss and make a recommendation to City Council on a zoning request to change the current zoning on about 0.556-acres at 106 West Farmers Road (being unplatted Tract 18 in the John Denton Abstract 426) from the R-4, Residential Single Family, zoning district to the R-5, Residential Single Family, zoning district.
