A. Discuss Regular Session Agenda Items

1. Discuss and consider a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Seagoville, Texas, awarding a unit price contract for asphalt repair to Anderson Asphalt & Concrete Paving, LLC; authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents; and providing an effective date (Community Development Director)

Halff Associates, Inc., Roberts stated this Resolution will award the unit price contract for asphalt repair to Anderson Asphalt & Concrete Paving, LLC.

7. Discuss and consider approving a Resolution of the City of Seagoville, Texas, authorizing the purchase of a 2020 Ford F-350 Diesel Crew Cab Utility vehicle for an amount not to exceed Fifty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Seven Dollars and Ninety Cents \$58,337.90 from Rush Truck Center; providing for the repeal of any and all Resolutions in conflict; providing for severability clause; and providing an effective date (Community Development Director)

Water Utilities Director Ryan stated this vehicle will replace an older vehicle that is in need of repair.

City Manager Stallings stated the purchase of this vehicle was approved in the current budget.

8. Discuss and consider development of a food truck/trailer court (City Manager)

City Manager Stallings stated Seagoville Economic Development Corporation met and discussed possibly creating a food truck/trailer court at C.O. Bruce Park. He also stated utilities and parking are available at the park to accommodate the food truck/trailer court.


