ORDINANCE NO. 10-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEAGOVILLE, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 17 ‘TRAFFIC’, ARTICLE 17.04 “PARKING, STOPPING OR STANDING”, DIVISION 2 “PARKING REGULATIONS FOR SPECIFIC STREETS”, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 17.04.067 TO PROVIDE FOR ONE (1) HOUR PARKING ON SEAGOVILLE ROAD, FROM ITS POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH BRUCE WAY SOUTHEAST A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 746 FEET TO ITS POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH THE U.S. HIGHWAY 175 SERVICE ROAD; AND PROVIDING FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRE LANE AND NO PARKING ZONE ON SEAGOVILLE ROAD, BEGINNING AT ITS POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH BRUCE WAY EXTENDING SOUTHWEST APPROXIMATELY 197 FEET TO ITS POINT OF DEAD END; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO CAUSE THE APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE TO BE ERECTED; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City provides for no stopping, standing or parking on specific streets within the City when signs are erected or curbs are painted on such street providing notice; and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Seagoville and serves the public welfare to limit parking on one specific area of Seagoville Road and to prohibit the stopping, standing and parking on another specific area of Seagoville Road, as described herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAGOVILLE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Seagoville, Texas, be, and the same is hereby amended, by amending Chapter 17, “Traffic”, Article 17.04 “Parking, Stopping or Standing”, Division 2. “Parking Regulations for Specific Streets”, by adding a new Subsection 17.4.67 to read in its entirety as follows:

“Chapter 17 Traffic

...

Article 17.04 Parking, Stopping or Standing

...

Division 2 Parking Regulations for Specific Streets

...

Sec. 17.04.067 Seagoville Road at Bruce Way

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to leave, stand, or park any motor vehicle or other vehicle or impediment for more than one (1) hour on either side of Seagoville Road, beginning at its point of intersection with Bruce Way and southeast for a distance of approximately 746 feet to its point of intersection with the U.S. Highway 175 Service Road.

(b) The roadside adjacent to Seagoville Road in both directions, beginning at its point of intersection with Bruce Way and continuing southwest for a distance of approximately 197 feet to its point of dead end is hereby designated as a fire lane and it shall be unlawful for any person to leave, stand, or park any motor vehicle or other vehicle or impediment at any time on either side of Seagoville Road, beginning at its point of intersection with Bruce Way and southwest for a distance of approximately 197 feet to its point of dead end.

Secs. 17.04.068-17.04.090 Reserved”

SECTION 2. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby directed to cause appropriate signs to be erected or curbs and areas to be marked giving notice of the provisions of Section 17.04.067 as established herein and such provision shall not be effective unless such signs or markings are in place at the time of an alleged offense.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City of Seagoville in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City of Seagoville not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That an offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and the provisions of the Code of Ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.


SECTION 5. That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

SECTION 6. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Seagoville, as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and Charter in such cases provide.


