LOCAL MEN ARRESTED FOR DAMAGING VEHICLES, POLICE SEEKING ANY ADDITIONAL VICTIMS

SEAGOVILLE, TX- On the night of December 23, 2017, the Seagoville Police Department began to receive several reports of vehicles being vandalized in the neighborhood around Central Elementary school. While responding to this area, a Seagoville Police Officer was able to locate two suspects in the act of vandalizing a vehicle. These suspects attempted to flee from responding officers in a vehicle, which initiated a brief vehicle pursuit. While attempting to flee police, the suspects crashed into a tree in a front yard of a home in the neighborhood. They were taken into custody by Seagoville Police Officers and jailed.

These individuals were identified as ANTHONY REYES-FLORES, 18, and SABINO IVAN LEON, 17; both of Seagoville. Based on the aggregate monetary amount of damages caused by these two individual's, each is charged with the felony offense of Criminal Mischief \geq \$2,500<\$30,000. ANTHONY REYES-FLORES was also subsequently charged with Evading Arrest or Detention with a Vehicle and Resisting Arrest, Search or Transport.

Seagoville Police detectives were able to contact and identify thirty two (32) victims in this case thus far. If you have a vehicle that was damaged in this neighborhood during the night of this event and have not come forward, you are urged to contact Detective Scott Koger at (972) 287-6816.

This case is forwarded to the Dallas County District Attorney's Office for prosecution. Victims will be able to request restitution through their office.
