VEHICLE PURSUIT LEADS TO RECOVERY OF STOLEN VEHICLE AND ARREST OF TWO WANTED FELONS

SEAGOVILLE, TX- On the morning of February 15, 2018, a Seagoville Police Officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a Chevrolet pickup for displaying wrong license plates. The driver of this vehicle failed to stop and a vehicle pursuit ensued. This pursuit led officers through Seagoville, into Combine, then into areas of unincorporated Dallas County.

This pursuit ended when the suspect left the road and crashed into a wooded area on South Beltline Road near the intersection of Beckett Road. After crashing this pickup, two suspects fled into a heavily wooded area on foot. The passenger, identified as SAMANTHA PATRICE MANSEAU, 28, of Balch Springs, was soon apprehended by pursuing officers. After a continued search of these woods, the driver and second suspect was located and apprehended. He was identified as JACOB NORMAN HOLT, 25, also of Balch Springs.

Both MANSEAU and HOLT had active felony arrest warrants at the time of their arrest. SAMANTHA MANSEAU was subsequently charged with the misdemeanor offense of Evading Arrest or Detention. JACOB HOLT was charged with two additional felonies, Evading Arrest or Detention with a Vehicle and Unauthorized Use of Vehicle.

The Chevrolet pickup was reported stolen through the Mesquite Police Department. No persons or officers were injured during this incident. Deputies with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department, along with air support from the TXDPS helicopter assisted the Seagoville Police Department in the apprehension of these suspects.
