ACTIVE SHOOTER RESPONSE TO U.S. ARMY RESERVE CENTER

SEAGOVILLE, TX- On Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at around 9:27 AM, the Seagoville Police Department received a 9-1-1 call from the U.S. Army Reserve Center in the 700 block of West Simonds Road with report of an active shooter inside a building.

The initial arriving Seagoville Police Officers entered the identified building under Active Shooter Event Response protocol. No suspect was encountered.

Assistance was requested from the Dallas County Sheriff's Department, the Dallas Police Department and the Texas Department of Public Safety Air Support. With the assistance from the Dallas County Sheriff's Office, officers conducted meticulous secondary searches of all buildings on the complex. Numerous soldiers and civilian personnel were found barricaded inside offices in compliance with their trained response to an Active Shooter Event.

Through secondary building searches, evidence was discovered inside the initial building that leads investigators to suggest a handgun was accidentally discharged into the floor by a person with access to this building. A bullet fragment was recovered.

Officials do not believe there is a public concern for safety. No injuries were reported to anyone during this event. The scene was cleared at around 2:00 PM of all responding resources.

This investigation will be forwarded to the US Army Criminal Investigation Division.
